## ST. CUTHMAN

Little of Cuthman is known with certainty. We suppose he was a Cornish Shepherd lad who, after his father's death, was compelled, because of extreme poverty, to seek sustenance for his sick mother to whom he was devoted. For her convenience he made a cart in which he placed her. This he drew, first by means of a rope and, later, when the rope broke, with one made of elder wood: and together they journeyed eastward until they reached Steyning where Cuthman was inspired to build a church to the glory of God.

Christopher Fry's play includes two legendary incidents which have from earliest times been associated with the saint.
